



# heritage open days

# Sunday 11 September 2016, 11am-5pm

The Founder's Building, commissioned by entrepreneur, Thomas Holloway and opened by Queen Victoria in 1886, is modelled on the Château de Châmbord in the Loire Valley. Its flamboyant architecture makes it one of the most impressive university buildings in the world.
