

Minutes recorded in the Senior Student's notebook, November 1895

Transcript:

At a general meeting of the graduates and undergraduates of the College summoned by Miss Kyle in November 1895 the following resolution was passed:

“That this meeting is of opinion [*sic*] that in view of the explicit recognition by the Government of Bedford College as a College for Women and in view of the misapprehensions awakened in various quarters, by the youth of some who attend it, that all students should adopt during College hours a style of dress which will lead to no erroneous views regarding the status of the College and afford no justification for its confusion with secondary girls' schools which appropriate the name of College without having collegiate traditions or university relations”.

In accordance with the above, the Senior Student was requested to communicate the opinion of the meeting to all students who attend the College with hair down.
