Transcript:

A general meeting was held on Monday Oct. 19th at 1.30 in the Large Lecture Hall. The Senior Student was in the chair. She gave out that as a good many students had insinuated that they objected to wearing the College ties, which somewhat resembled German colours, she had brought the matter before the Principal, who thought that by continuing to wear the colours discredit might be brought upon the College. The colours therefore were not to be worn [for the present].
