Top Tips for Assessment Centres



For the Mini Tutorial:

- Rehearse/edit your mini-tutorial to check it fits into **8 minutes**
- Share **learning outcomes** and think carefully about whether these can be met in the time and **how**
- Ensure that you **engage with both assessors** who are acting as 14 year old pupils – think about how you would do this with pupils
- **Don't lecture** - include interactive activities
- **Introduce yourself as a PhD researcher/** share what your research is about
