

SENTIO CALL FOR REVIEWERS

Dear All,

Sentio Journal is now seeking peer-reviewers to review submissions for the upcoming fifth issue!

Sentio Journal, the SeNSS interdisciplinary journal, is seeking reviewers across all 3 sections of the journal: articles, reviews, and reflections, all based around this year's theme of "Past, Present, Future". The current submission deadline for authors is Monday 1st May, and reviews will need to be completed between approximately Monday 8th May – Friday 22nd June 2023.

Reviewers must be postgraduate students/researchers or early-career researchers, and ideally studying/researching a social sciences subject. Although previous reviewing experience would be helpful, it is not necessary as **full training will be offered to all reviewers**, along with detailed instructions on how to complete the review.

Peer review experience is an excellent addition to your skillset and CV, demonstrating an ability to think critically, apply your expertise to other areas of research, and be exposed to areas of research that you may not normally interact with. Moreover, you will further hone existing skills such as creative thought, time management, and effective communication.

Given the broad interdisciplinary scope of the journal, we would like to recruit a diverse pool of peer-reviewers from UK universities and beyond. To this end, we would be grateful if you could forward this call for reviewers on to any colleagues or students that may be interested in this opportunity. Compared to traditional journals, reviewing for Sentio does not represent a significant time commitment. We would expect that only 1-2 hours is spent on each submission, and each reviewer may review as little as one submission, up to as many as they are available to commit to.
