

CONSTANCE WEST TRAVEL AWARD

Constance West was appointed in 1928 as a lecturer in the French Department at Royal Holloway College. She left the College in 1932 but returned as a Senior Lecturer in 1935 and worked here until her retirement in 1965. Between 1946 and 1950 she was Vice Principle.

Conditions of the Award.

- 1. The Award will be made to a student of Modern Languages for travel expenses, cost of further courses and/or training.
- 2. The application must include a reference from the Head of Department concerned.
- 3. Applications will be considered by The Travel Awards and College Prizes Allocation Panel who will consult the Head of the School of Modern Languages before making an award.
- 4. Recipients of the Award are required to submit a brief report of the activities for which they have utilised the Award. This report will be published on the Royal Holloway Travel Awards and College Prizes webpage.
