

DAME FELICITY LOTT SCHOLARSHIP

Following a Bicentary Recital given by Dame Felicity Lott at Crossland House in 2000, a scholarship fund was established. The aim of this fund is to support a student graduating from Royal Holloway University of London who wishes to seek professional training as a performer.

Conditions of the Award:

- 1. The Scholarship is open to all final year students who intend to progress to a professional career as a performer of music. It is not limited to those pursuing a music degree.
- 2. If pursuing a BMus degree, applicants must have taken Performance in the final year.
- 3. Applicants must be able to provide evidence of excellence in their field as an intending professional musician, supported by a statement of their achievements and two references one of which must be from an academic source.
- 4. The Travel Awards and College Prizes Allocation Panel will consider applications for the Award and consult Dame Felicity Lott before making a recommendation to the Academic Awards Group.
- 5. Recipients of the Award are required to submit a brief report of the activities for which they have utilised the Award, which will be forwarded to Dame Felicity Lott. This report will be published on the Royal Holloway Travel Awards and College Prizes webpage.
