

UNA ELLIS-FERMOR AWARD

Una Ellis-Fermor was a Professor of English Language and Literature from 1947 until 1958. She was a member of the English Department at Royal Holloway College between 1918 and 1958. The Award was endowed to provide assistance for research students in the publication of scholarly work, including travel, in the field of English, Irish or Scandinavian Drama.

Conditions of the Award:

- The Award is open to postgraduate research students in the field of English, Irish or Scandinavian Drama who consider that such an award would assist them in the publication of scholarly work, including undertaking travel.
- 2. Applications will be considered by The Travel Awards and College Prizes Allocation Panel who will consult the Head of the Department of Drama before making an award.
- 3. Recipients of the Award are required to submit a brief report of the activities for which they have utilised the Award. This report will be published on the Royal Holloway Travel Awards and College Prizes webpage.
