

Top Tips for Living Off-Campus...

TV Licence - Your TV is not covered by your parents' licence so make sure you apply for one. www.tvlicensing.co.uk/students

Be a good neighbour -

Introduce yourselves when you move in to help establish a positive relationship.

Home Security - Insure your possessions against damage and theft. Pick up an application leaflet from the SU.

Rubbish & Recycling - Runnymede operate a fortnightly recycling collection and fortnightly black bin collection (for those items that can't be recycled) on alternate weeks. Food recycling is collected weekly. Check when your collection day is www.runnymede.gov.uk 0800 052 0067 or by asking your neighbours.

Utility bills - Don't let arguments over paying bills affect your friendships! Agree how your household bills will be paid/split between you. All tenants names should appear on the bills. Meter readings should be recorded when you move in and vacate the property.

Top Tips for Living Off-Campus...

Non - residential bus - if you live within a 3 mile radius of the College you can use the Student Union bus which runs every night during term time. Tickets can be purchased from the SU reception.

Be safe - try not to walk home alone after dark, stick to well lit main roads and stay alert - unplug your ipod! You can pick up a free personal safety alarm from FW 170.

Tidy - Be responsible for ensuring you keep your home and garden free from waste.

Doctor - Don't wait until you need a doctor before registering! Check with the College Health Centre (Founder's East 1st floor) to see if you're in their catchment area. If you're not, they can advise you on your nearest surgery.

Parties and noise - no noise after 11pm on a night preceding a weekday. If you are planning a party give your neighbours lots of notice and try to agree a reasonable end time to the party. You might also consider inviting your neighbours to join you!
