Two-Year MSc Programmes

Progression	Year One (Stage One)
Course outcomes	<p>Pass 120 credits (three 30 credit courses AND two 15 credit courses with a minimum 50% in each module)</p> <p>AND</p> <p>Achieve a Stage average of minimum 55% overall.</p>
Department Requirements	All courses <u>must</u> be passed in order to progress the second year of the MSc (2 year) programme

MSc Programmes

Progression	Graduation
Course outcomes	<p>Pass 120 credits to progress to dissertation in the summer with minimum 50% in each module.</p> <p>Only two condonable fails of 40 – 49% in 20 credit courses are allowed</p> <p>Pass 180 credits over the year to graduate (six 20 credit courses and the 60 credit Dissertation)</p> <p>AND</p> <p>Achieve a Stage average of minimum 50% overall.</p>
Department Requirements	<p>All courses must be passed, including non-credit courses.</p> <p>Dissertation is non-condonable</p>
