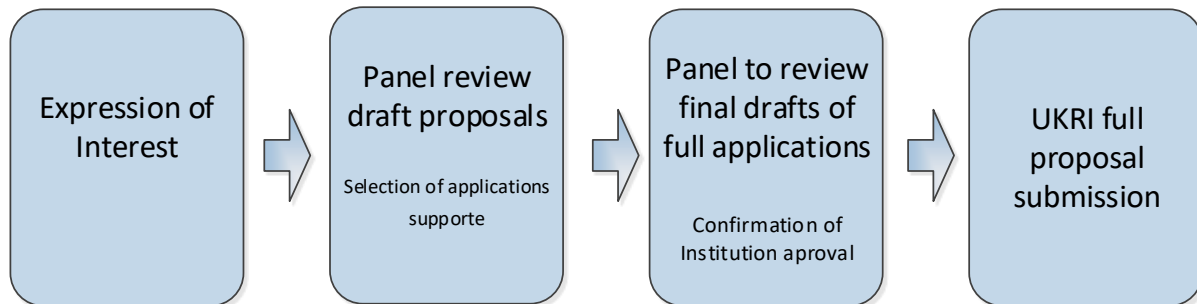


Internal selection UKRI Future Leaders Fellowship scheme



1. Expression of Interest

- Fellows are requested to submit an Expression of Interest (EoI) to R&I*.
- EoIs will be reviewed by an internal College panel chaired by the Deputy Principal (Academic) and with a representation from Schools and support from R&I.
- Selected applicant(s) will be invited to develop a full proposal. The decision will be based on the quality of the applications and match with the scheme requirements. Applicant(s) will be informed shortly after the review meeting and asked to draft a full proposal.

2. Application development

- The fellow will be supported in the application development by R&I and their host department.

3. Final Sign off

- The panel will reconvene to review the final drafts of the selected proposal(s). Proposal(s) should be complete to a point they are ready to submit. The panel will give a final yes/no decision on whether the application is of sufficient quality to be submitted.

*EOI/Outline application request

- a maximum 3 page summary of the planned project structured around the assessment criteria
 - Research and Innovation Excellence
 - Applicant and their Development
 - Impact and Strategic development
- a maximum two page CV
- the Head of the hosting Department asked to outline the following
 - why is the fellow an outstanding candidate
 - how does the host department provide an excellent research environment for the project
 - what training, mentoring and other steps will be taken to support the fellow to establish themselves as a leader in their field
 - fit to Research Strategy
