Guide for Internal Competition: Leverhulme Early Career Fellowship

The Leverhulme Early Career Fellowship enables early career researchers to undertake a significant piece of publishable work and covers 50% of fellow's total salary costs up to £25k per year with the remaining balance paid by the College. The Fellowship is for 3 years.

NOTE: In response to the COVID-19 pandemic the Leverhulme will fund the fellow's salary at 100% in year one of the award with the 50% model (outlined above) returning for years 2 and 3.

The College will normally support the submission of a maximum of 10 applications.

Timeline

Internal deadline for EOIs- **Monday 30th November 2020**. Please send to Research Services

Internal selection – **mid-December 2020**

Leverhulme Deadline – **25th Feb 2021** (the competition opens in **January 2021**)

EOI/Outline application request

Please include the following:

- A one A4 page summary of the planned project
- A maximum two page CV
- Confirmation of Head of the hosting Department support

Where there is more than one application within a School, applications will be ranked by the School (process to be determined by each School Director of Research in liaison with their Research Leads). This will help to inform the college panel when assessing applications.

Internal selection will be made by a panel of School Directors of Research, chaired by the Deputy Principal (Academic) or her nominee. The panel will comprise at least 3 DoRs.
