Aim: Catch22 is a local charity with a national reach. We work with young people who find themselves in difficult situations. We believe every young person deserves the chance to get on in life - no matter what.

Role: Catch 22 wish to fill the role of National Citizen Service Support Volunteer who will be required to support young people during their time on the National Citizen Service programme during summer 2011. Young people will require support in taking part in a summer-long programme of residential trips and leadership programmes, culminating in their participation in volunteering in the local community.

Training: All volunteers receive an induction into their role which includes an introduction to the organisation, the service and the young people. Training for each of the different volunteering roles is specific to the requirements of the role and may be on the job training or a more comprehensive accredited opportunity.

Location: Woking, Godalming & Tandridge

Times: They are looking for volunteers that are able to attend any of the sessions below. It is not a requirement that you can volunteer for all sessions. If you would like to volunteer for all that is ok too.

DBS: A DBS disclosure is required for this project.

Other: All travel expenses would be paid and Catch22 will provide: regular high quality support and supervision access to and support to attend all required training ongoing personal development through involvement in other Catch2 projects other such support that is required and practical.
