London Nightline

Aim: London Nightline is a non-judgemental listening service for students in London. Student volunteers operate a telephone, email and online helpline throughout the night, between 6pm and 8am throughout term time. They aim to support and provide an empathetic ear to students across London during the hours of the night when other support services may not be available.

Role:

Hotline Volunteer!

They are looking to recruit volunteers to take calls, starting in October. After the training, volunteers commit to 12 night shifts each academic year. It's a great opportunity to get to know other nice people, learn listening skills and learn about mental health.

Publicity Volunteer!

They need people to help raise awareness among students for the charity. The publicity team meets about once every two weeks (or more frequently as required) to organise publicity events and design publicity materials at all affiliated universities across London.

Fundraising Volunteer!

Help to raise funds and support the running of the charity. The fundraising team meets about once every two weeks (or more frequently as required) to design and plan targeted fundraising in the form of grants, events planning and other creative ways of fundraising.

Training:

Hotline Volunteers:

Training runs in three parallel evening sessions:

All project volunteers must be registered as Community Action Volunteers.

- October 8th, 15th and 22nd OR
- October 10th, 17th and 24th OR
- October 16th and a double session on October 20th

Location: Central London.

Times:

Hotline: Every night of term from 6pm-8am, including weekends. Term 1: Monday 26th September-Friday 16th December Term 2: Monday 9th January-Friday 30th March Term 3: Monday 23rd April-Friday 8th June.

Publicity Team: Twice every two weeks

Fundraising team: Twice every two weeks

DBS: A DBS disclosure is not required for this opportunity.

Other: Disabled access is, unfortunately, not good as office is located on top floor. Volunteers must be fluent in English.
