Aim: Dyslexia Action is a national charity and the UK's leading provider of services and support for people with dyslexia and literacy difficulties. They are committed to improving public policy and practice. They partner with schools, Local Authorities, colleges, universities, employers, voluntary sector organisations and the Government to improve the quality and quantity of help for people with dyslexia and specific learning difficulties. Their services are available through our 26 centres and 160 teaching locations around the UK. Over half a million people benefit from our work each year. Their mission is to ensure that all individuals with dyslexia are identified and educated to allow them to be successful.

Role: Volunteers may be involved in various tasks, supporting the day to day activities of the Fundraising and Marketing, or Training departments in Head Office.

Training: The intern will be supported throughout and given regular opportunities to discuss their work with a manager.

Location: Englefield Green (near Savill Garden).

Times: The length, days and hours of the internships are flexible, but it is likely that most internships will last between three and six months.

CRB: A CRB check will be required via the Community Partner.
