Aim: Darley Dene is a sheltered house which supports residents of the 60+ age group. They provide trips out, activities and lunches on site. They aim to keep all their residents in independent living for as long as they are able.

Role: They require help with activities and are particularly looking for a volunteer that is art based and can help with one-off workshops. They also need help serving food to residents at the communal lunches and help with general gardening.

Training: There is no specific training for this project, but the Sheltered Housing Manager will always be on site.

Location: Darley Dene House, very close to Addlestone train station (12 minute train ride from Egham).

Times: Mainly between 10am and 3pm, Monday – Friday.

CRB: This project requires a CRB disclosure via the Community Partner.
