IT Tutoring Refugee and Asylum seekers

Aim: To provide a service teaching IT to refugees and asylum seekers aged 15-18 in a social services residence, which will equip and enable them to grow in confidence and provide them with skills they can use in later life

Role: Volunteers work at a residence for 15 to 18 year-old unaccompanied asylum seekers and refugees, providing IT-tuition. Ideal volunteer has a good working knowledge of basic computer skills.

Training: The volunteers will teach a curriculum developed especially for this project.

Location: Uxbridge (transport provided).

Times: Wednesday and/or Thursday evenings 6-8pm fortnightly during term time & some holidays.

CRB: This project requires a CRB disclosure via Community Action office.

Other: Volunteers will be reimbursed travel expenses and the project has accessibility.
