Aim: The Forest Estate Community Hub, Englefield Green was opened on 31st October 2012 and is run by a multi-agency group led by The Journey-River Church. The Hub exists primarily for residents looking to serve the estate with everyone focused on working together to provide inspiration, support and skills enabling individuals to reach their full potential. In their first year the main aim has been to develop a successful program to engage the 7-12 age group.
