Egham Youth Centre

Aim: Youth clubs seek to provide an environment where local young people can come and meet friends, be involved with activities and gain support. Aiming to provide a safe friendly space where they can come and use the recreational facilities available to them.

Role: To work alongside the youth workers team to provide a safe environment with activities for local young people who use the club. To work with the youth team to build up a rapport and work with the youth who come and use the centre. This may involve outdoor/indoor sports activities, cooking, arts and crafts or the use of the other rooms/facilities in the youth centre.

Training: Supported by the Egham Youth Centre Team.

Location: Egham Youth Centre (Limes Road, opposite Strode's College).

Times: There are various nights in the week when you can volunteer. The main nights are Monday 6:15-8:45pm and Wednesday 7-9:30pm. The Wednesday session is run in conjunction with the local police. Both these sessions are for secondary school-aged children (11-16). There is also the possibility of volunteering on a Tuesday night with young people who have learning difficulties.

CRB: This project requires a CRB disclosure via Community Action office.

Other: The project has accessibility. SU clubs and societies are welcome to run series of workshops or sports sessions with the young people.
