**Aim:** To work flat out to get every child their rights as fast as possible.

**Role:** Save the Children are looking for 'Emergency Fundraisers' - volunteers who are asked to raise money for emergencies as soon as they happen. You can do anything you wish to raise the money within a couple of weeks from hosting a tea party, or taking a collection tin around work.

**Training:** None needed! All you have to do to be an Emergency Fundraiser is sign up on the website ([savethechildren.org.uk/hero](http://savethechildren.org.uk/hero)). Then, when an emergency happens let Save the Children know if you want to fundraise and they'll send you a pack.

**Location:** Anywhere and everywhere.

**Times:** Emergency fundraising is a totally flexible form of volunteering. Simply sign up and, when an emergency happens, they are sent information and advice about fundraising for a specific emergency.

**CRB:** No CRB disclosure is required.

**Other:** Fundraising ideas need to be submitted in advance to Save the Children UK for risk assessment and recording activities.
