Aim: To provide AS and A-Level students with an excellent education and support them in their learning.

Role: Volunteers will support AS and A-Level students of German, Spanish or French in their language studies, especially in preparing them for the oral exam. Subject teachers work very closely with volunteers and support them in their work. Volunteers would work one-to-one with individual students. A volunteer would have to be a competent linguist (skills above A-Level) and be happy to work with young people. It is very important that volunteers are reliable, punctual and enthusiastic. They should also work closely together with subject teachers to maximise the benefit for students. This project is particularly beneficial for any volunteer seeking to pursue a career in teaching.

Training: Subject teachers train volunteers and are available for support. They also keep in close contact with volunteers about their work on a weekly basis.

Location: Strode's College, Egham

Times: The college day starts at 8.45 and finishes at 16.10. Days and times can be arranged to suit the volunteer during these hours.
